Our Approach

Aqua Warrior operates within a coastal foreshore environment, and sustainability is built into how we run the park each day. Our focus is on practical, low-impact operations that protect the surrounding waterway, reduce resource use, and contribute positively to the local community.

We prioritise real, consistent actions over broad statements, ensuring our operations remain responsible, efficient and appropriate for the environment we operate in.

What We Currently Do

Water Use & Environmental Protection

- The park operates using natural ocean water for all sprinklers, ensuring no drinking or fresh water unnecessarily is used or discharged into the environment
- No chemicals are used in park operations, protecting the surrounding marine ecosystem
- Continuous monitoring of the site to prevent debris entering the waterway
- Active cleaning and waste collection carried out throughout each operating day

Waste Reduction & Resource Use

- Fully paperless operations, including digital waivers, bookings and receipts
- Clearly labelled waste and recycling bins available to guests
- Container for Change collection points to encourage recycling and responsible disposal
- Ongoing focus on reducing unnecessary material use across operations

Energy Use

- Use of solar panels to support a portion of on-site energy requirements
- Monitoring of energy use across operations to identify efficiencies

Equipment & Longevity

- Regular maintenance and repair of inflatable equipment to extend lifespan
- Preventative inspections to reduce damage and avoid unnecessary replacement



Emissions & Energy Awareness

Aqua Warrior's primary sources of emissions relate to:

- Electricity used for park operations and equipment
- Transport and logistics associated with setup and maintenance

Through reduced water use, solar energy integration, and efficient operational practices, we actively work to minimise our overall environmental footprint.

Community & Social Impact

Aqua Warrior is committed to supporting the local community and providing inclusive access to outdoor recreation.

- Providing employment opportunities for a diverse local workforce
- Hosting school groups, community organisations and NDIS-supported participants
- Taking a personalised approach to accessibility and support needs
- Donating tickets and prizes to local not-for-profit organisations and community initiatives

- Introduce company-wide sustainability awareness and training
- Embed environmental responsibility into daily procedures and expectations
